LORENA WIEBES OPENS THE HONOR ROLL

It was an extremely long delivery before the birth of the first Scheldeprijs for women. To avoid conflicts with the Dutch Healthy Aleing Tour the women's edition was delayed time after time. Until Paris-Roubaix for women was added to the calendar, the Dutch moving their race to early March and thus creating space for the first Ladies Scheldeprijs.

The interest to start in Schoten was overwhelming, several teams had to be denied from participating. Finally 28 teams and 152 riders were allowed to start.

The route included a long stretch through the Nord Kempen and three local laps in Schoten. In the first hour the ladies covered 42,5 km. The peloton broke into pieces and a few crashes, none serious, eliminated some of the riders. In the local laps Daniek Hengeveld took a 1'20" lead but in the final lap the peloton quickly approached. Also the Italian Letizia Borghesi made an effort to break away from the pack but it all came together and a sprint would need to decide on a winner. It was the fast Dutch rider Lorena Wiebes who became the first female winner of the new Scheldeprijs.

LORENA WIEBES REMAINS UNBEATEN IN THE SCHELDEPRIJS

Lorena Wiebes won the first Scheldeprijs for women last year and started again as the favourite. The very international peloton - 140 women strong - remained tight despite the wind and rain. There was also no definitive breakaway during the three local laps. A trio of women took a limited lead for a while but Simone Boilard (Canada), Abi Smith (Great Britain) and Megan Armitage (Ireland) were caught up in the final local lap. The lead peloton was decimated by a fall along the canal, but nothing could prevent Lorena Wiebes from winning again on Churchillaan. She took the lead from afar and there was no one who could threaten her.

LORENA WIEBES ACHIEVES A PERFECT HAT TRICK

142 women start in Schoten in the third edition of the Scheldeprijs for women.

Top favourite is of course Lorena Wiebes, the double winner. On that part of the course by Kalmthout, Wuustwezel and Brecht, an escape is underway. After a fruitless attempt by Mieke Docx, a group containing Kelly Van den Steen, Balutte Van der Wulf, Amandine Fouquet, Simone Boilard and Katrijn De Clercq is successful. In the local laps, Sara Van de Vel and Noëlle Ruetschli join the leaders. The group enters the final lap with a 45-second lead. As expected, the peloton catches up and this edition also ends with a mass sprint in which Lorena Wiebes is once again the fastest. She defeats her compatriot Charlotte Kool and Italy's Chiara Consonni. For the time being, there is just one name on the honours board of the Scheldeprijs for women: three times Lorena Wiebes!

LORENA WIEBES REMAINS UNBEATABLE IN SCHOTEN

The question at the start in Schoten: who will beat Lorena Wiebes?

The (expected) answer followed a few hours later: Nobody!

This means that the female Scheldeprijs honours board contains just one name: Lorena Wiebes.

Friend and foe alike have to agree, the Dutch rider is the fastest in the world. She has already proved this in so many races and in the 4th Scheldeprijs for women she very clearly did so once again.

Earlier in the race, Dutch rider Anneke Dijkstra and the Fin Wilma Aintila had been the busiest attackers but with 2 km to go, they were swamped by the peloton.

In the sprint, there was no one to match Wiebes. Charlotte Kool and Martina Fidanza sprinted their way to the other places on the podium.

Hit could hardly have been any different: sunshine, huge crowds, spring in the air and, above all, a highly motivated Italian campionissima!

Elisa Balsamo proved strongest in the sprint, getting the better of Dutch speedster Charlotte Kool. In the absence of four-time winner Lorena Wiebes, all eyes were on Balsamo. She had previously finished seventh (2024) and third (2021) in Schoten, but this year - an interesting detail - she chose to skip the Tour of Flanders to go all in for the Scheldeprijs! That was some serious motivation right there! She did not disappoint and claimed a brilliant victory, after several breakaway attempts earlier in the race, including late moves by Luxembourg's Marie Schreiber and Britain's Zoë Backstedt. Charlotte Kool, narrowly beaten, finished second for the third year in a row (2023-24-25) en Chiara Consonni (2nd in 2022, 3rd in 2023, 8th in 2024) completed the Italian-tinted podium.
